POSITION SUMMARY:

Animal Enrichment volunteers are essential for maintaining happy and healthy animals at NCAL. These volunteers will participate in various enrichment activities to help stimulate the animals minds, ultimately reducing stress while living in the kennel environment. Enrichment volunteers can set up puzzle games, special feeding toys and games, practice teaching dogs to sit or calmly walk on a leash. Enrichment volunteers can also just spend time with a needed dog or cat that is looking for a lap.

Please note: This position is a segway position for Dog Walkers. Each volunteer that is interested in dog walking will need to start out in the Animal Enrichment role to gain experience and knowledge about NCAL animals.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Facilitate special enrichment games for dogs or cats
- Follow protocols to help teach dogs basic training foundations
- Learn to safely harness dogs and how to walk them throughout the shelter
- Spend quality time with shelter animals that are in need of socialization and training

- Comfortable lifting over 20lbs
- Comfortable handling cleaning agents and organic matter
- Ability to follow directions
